Fall In Love With Escondido Schools

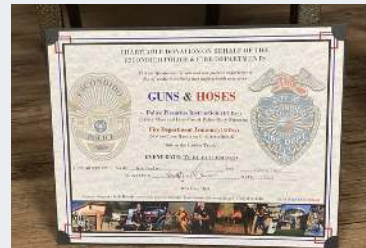
