Large Donation To EEF

Earlier this year EEF leadership was contacted by Mr. Matthew Bowers, the vice president of the Calver Foundation, a Texas based private foundation.

Mr. Bowers met with EEF President Ali Parviz and former president Carolyn Royer and discussed granting EEF a donation to support the grants we give to EUSD educators each year. The Calver Foundation requested budgetary information from EEF and after several months decided to grant EEF \$25,000 for the 2026-2027 school year!

The donation is awarded stipulating each EUSD school gets two \$500 grants.

EEF is very thankful to the Calver Foundation for their generous donation. We will work diligently to ensure this money is granted to all schools in EUSD.
